Coral reef fishes are an important source of food for people who live near the oceans. People there also make money by fishing. But sometimes, people catch too many fish – that is “overfishing”. Overfishing is bad for the coral reef system and it would lower the numbers and kinds of fish in the sea. At the same time, it's also bad for the people in the nearby areas. These people often work as fishermen. When they can't catch enough fish, they may not be able to take care of their families. So, bees and chickens come into play.

The “income diversification projects”, like keeping honeybees or raising egg-laying chickens, show fishermen and their families new ways to make money. When the people near the oceans have new skills to make a living, they don't have to overfish. This brings about a win-win situation- people do not need to make money in only one way, and the coral reefs get the chance to recover.

By getting different ways to make a living, people can now make money and be friendly to the coral reefs at the same time.



It is said that our palms can tell something about ourselves. Do you want to know what your palm says to you? Just take a look at your palm, and you will find that palm reading is very interesting.




